

For a cyclist on the 400 km Central West Cycle Trail (CWCT), the small town of Mendooran is accommodation, the classic pub or club meal, local produce of cheese, honey, pickles and meats, a surprise package distillery, a rich trove of photographic opportunities created by a diverse architecture and some great quiet gravel road cycling. The weekend of May 4-5 seeks to display the food and cycling opportunities of Mendooran and be a fundraiser for the CWCT. The key get-together event after your day of cycling or just enjoying the town, bees, distillery, architecture, riverfront etc is the "Tastes of Mendooran", starting at 5pm on Saturday 4 May at the Showground – three courses \$30! Importantly the weekend is planned so that it caters for the cyclist and non-cyclist.

Emphasis of the weekend is riding when you like, along whichever route you like.

There are times set down when self-guided riders wishing to ride as a group will leave from the Mendooran Post Office-Mechanics Institute. This will make the ride more social. To give navigational confidence someone will be present who has ridden the route, or in the case of the Town Ride the route will be signposted. Times set out below.

Transport

The only public transport to Mendooran is NSW Trainlink, with the Lithgow to Mendooran leg being by bus. The Committee will be working to see if a system of freighting bicycles from Lithgow to Mendooran can be set up, whilst the cyclists travel by Trainlink bus.
